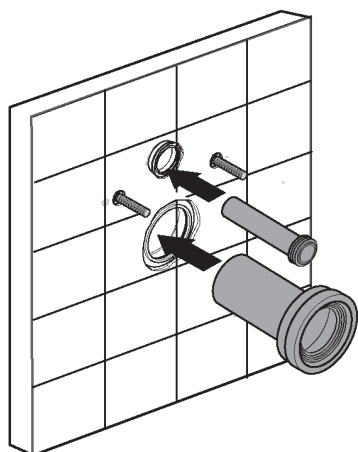




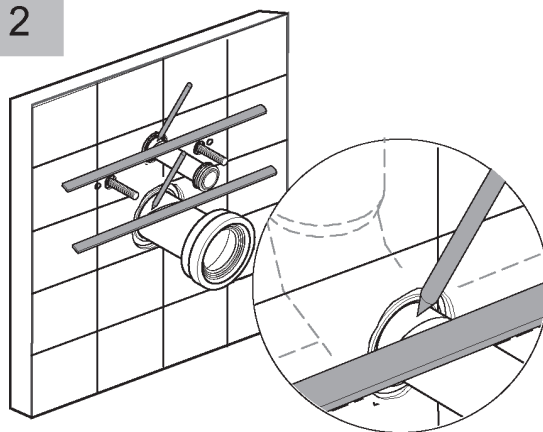


PAN INSTALLATION

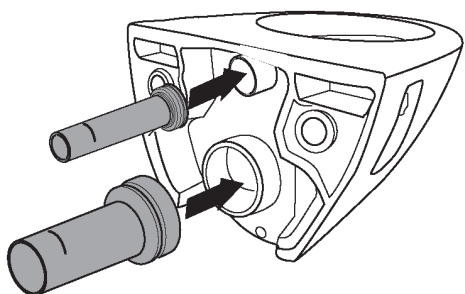

Insert the pipes into the installed cistern, mark the pipes where they cross the finished wall

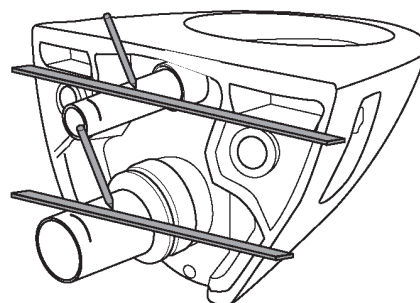

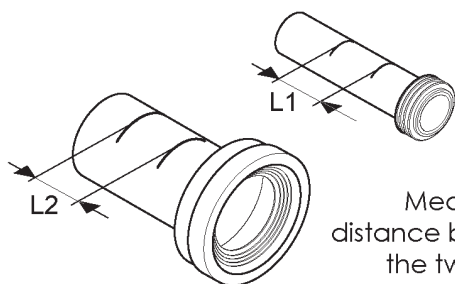
Insert the other end of the pipes into the pan with the seals fitted

Mark where it crosses the rear of the pan

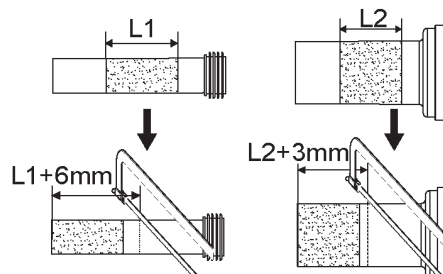

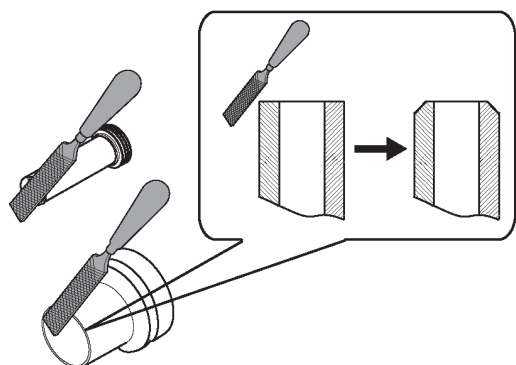
Measure the distance between the two marks and add 6mm for clearance

TROUBLE SHOOTING GUIDE:

SAFETY NOTICE: TURN OFF WATER SUPPLY WHEN SERVICING ANY COMPONENTS

Symtom	Possible Cause	Corrective Action
No Flush	Supply stop is closed	Open the supply stop
	Flush Plate not connected	Check Flush Plate is connected
	Flex hose is blocked or kinked	Check flex hose
Water Leaking into Pan	Outlet seal issue	Check outlet valve seal and outlet valve hosing, replace if required
	Inlet valve water height too high	Check water inlet height and adjust so it is lower than overflow tube
	Inlet seal leaking	Check inlet seal and replace if damaged

CARE & CLEANING:

1. Daily care will extend your Argent products lifespan. For the daily cleaning, we recommend using a soft, non-abrasive sponge or cloth, like Microfiber cloths. (Tip: Dampen microfiber cloths before use.)
2. If you wish to use a cleaning agent, it is recommended to use a standard, general-purpose cleaning agent.
